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About Natstand family documents:

A Natstand family document is intended to provide background information concerning the family of a deceased naturalist. It is hoped that such information will form a framework which will help interpret their surviving correspondence, specimens and records. In some cases it will also give an insight into the influences on their early lives and the family constraints within which they worked and collected. We have found that published family data concerning individuals rarely contain justification for dates and relationships and not infrequently contain errors which are then perpetuated. The emphasis in Natstand family documents will be on providing references to primary sources, whenever possible, which will be backed-up with transcriptions.

Although a Natstand biography page will always carry a link to a family document, in many cases these documents will be presented without any further biographical material. We anticipate that this will occur if the person is particularly well known or is someone we are actively researching or have only a peripheral interest in.

The following conventions are used:

Any persons in the family tree with known natural history associations will be indicated in red type. Any relationships will be to the root naturalist unless otherwise stated.

Dates are presented Year – Month – Day

e.g. **1820 March 9** or **1820.3.9**
1820 March or **1820.3**

Dates will be shown in bold type if a reliable reference is presented in the document. In cases where an exact year cannot be given (e.g. it is derived from an age at death), the date will be presented in normal type and preceded with "c" – e.g. c1798. There are some cases where a date is available from a secondary source only (e.g. a published obituary), in these cases it will be presented in italics – e.g. *1823.7.21*

Data sources:

Census data have been used, whenever possible, to confirm relationships; they are not considered a reliable source of data concerning age. Contemporary newspaper family notices are considered as reliable sources of relationships and dates; reports and obituaries are treated more cautiously. Parish records generally provide a reliable source of data and digitised images have been used whenever possible. Any difficulties with transcription will be made clear. In some cases only transcripts have been available; errors here are usually confined to spelling. The most important source of this material is the International Genealogical Index compiled by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Utah. National Civil Registration Indexes are considered reliable, as are probate records.

DIED. On the 8th instant, at Turnham Green, Middlesex, Henry Hewetson, Esq., aged 82, sincerely and deservedly respected. Mr H. was a native of Ravenstonedale, in this county, He died worth nearly a million of money, and among various other legacies, bequeathed to six nephews and nieces, residing in his native parish, and the adjoining parish of Orton, the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand pounds.

[He was a member of the United Company of merchants of England trading to the East-Indies - The East India Company.]

LATE MR. J. A. HEWETSON.

DEATH OF HIGHLY RESPECTED EAST HULL RESIDENT. (SPECIALLY CONTRIBUTED.)

Many friends in Hull and the East Riding will learn with great regret of the death Mr John Angelo Hewetson, which took place at his residence, 20, Jalland-street, at noon Friday last. Deceased, who was 76 years of age, was highly esteemed by a wide circle of friends both in business and private life. He was the son of Mr Henry Hewetson, and was born at Barton Hill Farm, Lincolnshire. He was grandson of John Hewetson, of Newland, who owned and resided on his estate which is now known as Newland Park.

Mr Hewetson was educated at the Leeds and Beverley Grammar Schools, and finished off his education at Brussels. He commenced his business career under an uncle with a shipping firm at Le Havre, afterwards transferring his services to a firm at Antwerp, and subsequently coming to Hull and entering the employ of Messrs Thomas Wilson and Sons, Ltd. He then learned the timber trade under Messrs. Allen and English, and subsequently joined Mr Braithwaite, of Courtney-street, the firm being Braithwaite and Hewetson.

Afterwards he founded the firm of Hewetson and Lambert, Dansom-lane, and later was for many years associated with the firm of A. Hewetson and Co., Ltd., until his retirement in 1924 when, as token of goodwill and esteem he was presented with beautiful timepiece by the staff.

Mr Hewetson married the youngest daughter of H. Frost, solicitor, of the firm of Frost and Dawson, of Hull, and granddaughter of the late Mr Charles Frost, solicitor to the old Hull Dock Company, and author of Frost's History of Hull." His bust is in the Hull Museum and his portrait in the Hull Subscription Library. Mr and Mrs Hewetson celebrated their golden wedding on November 10th, 1927. There were nine children of the marriage, seven of whom survive. One son is an engineer in Ohio, another is farming in New Zealand, while a daughter is resident in Los Angeles.

WELL-KNOWN IN POULTRY WORLD.

Mr Hewetson was well known for many years in the poultry world, and was an expert judge of poultry, rabbits and pigeons. He himself scored several notable successes at leading shows. In 1892 he won the National Cup with White Leghorn that was only beaten on one or two occasions, and this in a class of 170. He won first and special in an all England contest with a black minorca in a class of 500 in 1913. He won the silver cup for the best Dutch rabbit in the show at the Hull Kingston Club Show.

No fancier in Hull was more highly respected than Mr Hewetson. He was a prominent member of the old Hull Poultry Club, and was for a number of years the honoured president of the East Hull Fanciers' Association which was responsible for several creditable open shows the East Hull Baths.

Mr Hewetson had a brother who achieved some fame in the medical world. He was the late H. Bendelack Hewetson, M.R.C.S., F.Z.S., who was hon. surgeon at the Eye and Ear Department of the Leeds Infirmary. Another brother was a Captain in the Royal Navy and during the South African War had charge of the Island of St. Helena, and was afterwards instructor of the London Division R.N.V.R.
