<sup>2</sup> Mary Jessie Lowe took the stage as Marie Litton, eventually also becoming a theatre manager. She has an entry in the Dictionary of National Biography.

<sup>3</sup> In the 1891 Census Alice and her son Cecil Ralph are visiting her parents – whereabouts of the rest of the family are unknown. It seemed likely that there were other children in this large gap but in 1911 she (a widow) filled in the census form incorrectly and unnecessarily stated that there had been five children of the marriage, three still alive.

<sup>4</sup> George trained as a surgeon with his uncle John Lowe; the 1861 census records them living in King's Lynn.
